



Post Injection Aftercare

1. Immediately after the treatment, there may be mild redness, bruising, and/or swelling, as well as headaches, blistering, itching, discomfort, discoloration, back aches, and flu-like symptoms. There are normal side effects and may last 14 days or longer after your injection. To alleviate discomfort, use a cold compress, aloe Vera gel, or usual pain-relieving methods. Having no side effects is also normal.
2. Drooping skin including droopy eyelids can occur after a Botox injection. This temporary side effect may not appear for up to two weeks following the injection. It should subside within four weeks. Be sure to follow the directions of the injector. The use of Nascon A is recommended to help.
3. Refrain from straining, heavy lifting, or vigorous exercise for five days following your treatment. Increasing circulation can affect the Botox and Juvederm.
4. Do not have a facial, chemical peel, microdermabrasion, or laser treatment for up to two weeks following a Botox injection and at least six weeks following a Juvederm injection. In some cases, you can have a laser treatment prior to your injection with the consent of a Smooth Skin Centers' laser technician or injector.
5. Do not lie down or look down for four hours following your injection and sleep on an extra pillow for at least the first two nights following your injection. Do NOT sleep on your belly. Doing so can cause side effects, including droopy eye lids.
6. Do not use Retin-A, glycolic acid, Vitamin C, or Kinerase for 48 hours after your treatment.
7. Use of sun block rated at 15 SPF or higher is recommended for two weeks after your injection.
8. You may shower after your injection, using mild soap and warm water. Pat the skin dry.
9. Makeup and moisturizer may be used after the injection, if the skin is not too irritated. Pat the skin - do not rub.
10. Additional injections at the area of concern may be necessary for optimal results. Botox can last up to three months, while Juvederm typically lasts at least eight months. The biggest reason people are dissatisfied with their injection results is because they don't get enough product.
11. It may take up to four weeks for the Botox to take full effect. Juvederm is usually in full effect within three months. Feel free to contact our office after three weeks if no results can be seen. You may need additional product injected. There will be an additional charge for this additional product.
12. We do not issue refunds for unused or unwanted products or procedures, or for injections you have already received. If you are late to or miss an appointment, you will be responsible for paying for your treatment and may forfeit your deposit.
